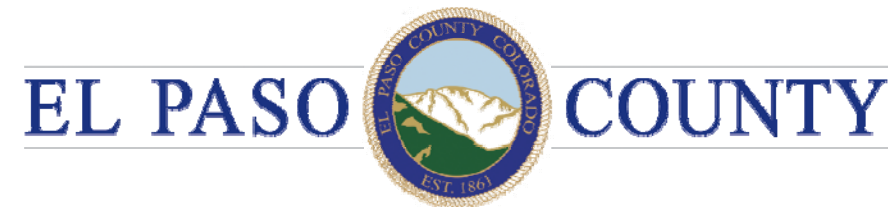

Important Information regarding our Health Center and Pharmacy services:

Dear County Health Plan Member:

We have great news to report to you. Our Request for Proposal (RFP) for clinic and pharmaceutical services is complete. The finalist is *Take Care Health Systems*, a “wholly owned subsidiary” of Walgreens and part of Walgreens Health and Wellness division.

Take Care Health Systems is the largest and most comprehensive provider of worksite health and wellness centers and convenient care clinics in the country. *Take Care* has more than 40 years of clinical service experience and Walgreens has extensive pharmaceutical service experience. *Take Care Health Systems* manages 650 employer health centers and convenient care clinics across the country, including 370 employer on-site health center programs. Our clinics will become “Health Centers” with the addition of medical doctors.

Medical Care

Take Care Health Systems will manage our primary care health centers with doctors in both locations. Nurse practitioner services will also be provided. The Health Centers will offer you and your enrolled dependents treatment for primary care services, including urgent care for headaches, nausea, flu, sprains, and cuts. In addition, health screenings, lab services, immunizations, annual physical exams, flu shots and cholesterol monitoring are available, in addition to other services. The Health Centers will be open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and will also be open during lunch.

Information on the 2009 Wellness Program will be provided in January.

The Health Plan Trust Board is very concerned about the increased costs for specialty care in 2009. As a result of the change in clinic and pharmacy providers, there will be some savings. We are happy to announce that with this savings the Trust Board was able to reduce the 2009 specialist co-pay from **\$125 to \$90**.

HEALTH CENTER AND PHARMACY TRANSITION

In preparation for the transition, the downtown Health Center and pharmacy will be closed beginning Thursday, December 24th. The East Health Center and Pharmacy will close Wednesday, December 31st at 1:00 pm.

Effective Thursday, January 1, 2009, employees, retirees and dependents enrolled on the County’s medical plan will have access to all 6,500+ Walgreens pharmacies nationwide, with 24 located right here in the El Paso County area, and 6 of these are open 24 hours a day. Opening in late January, we will have a new Walgreens on-site pharmacy located at the Regional Development Center (RDC) next to the new Health Center.

A new Health Center with greater capacity for appointments will be opening on January 5th at the Regional Development Center (RDC), located on the lower level of 2880 International Circle. Both the RDC and East Health Centers will open on Monday, January 5th, and will provide easy access and easy parking.

PHARMACY SERVICES—WALGREENS HEALTH INITIATIVES (WHI)

Members will have access to all Walgreens retail pharmacies for only \$1.50 above the in-house pharmacy copays. In addition, prescription mail service will be provided. The in-house pharmacy (opening late January at the RDC) hours will be Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Your new Walgreens prescription ID cards will be mailed to you in December. Please be sure to present your new prescription ID card when going to a pharmacy after January 1, 2009, so the pharmacy can update your insurance information. Other pertinent information about your prescription drug benefit will be provided soon within your Walgreens Prescription packets.

PHARMACY SERVICES—WALGREENS HEALTH INITIATIVES (WHI)

Filling Prescriptions at a Retail Pharmacy:

New Prescriptions at Retail Pharmacy

Starting January 1, 2009, present your new prescription ID card to the pharmacist. The pharmacist will process and fill the prescription(s) through WHI, and collect the appropriate co-payment.

Refill Prescriptions at Retail Pharmacy

If you have a current prescription at a retail pharmacy with valid refills, you will not need to obtain a new prescription(s) to continue to fill at that pharmacy. Present your new prescription ID card to the pharmacist at the time the prescription(s) is filled to ensure that your prescription insurance information is updated to process through WHI. The pharmacist will process and fill the prescription(s) through WHI, and collect the appropriate co-payment.

Filling Prescriptions at the Mail Service Pharmacy

Through the Prescription Drug Program, you can take advantage of convenient delivery of your covered maintenance medications to your home or other specified address. Maintenance medications are defined as medications that are used for chronic, long-term conditions such as high blood pressure, high cholesterol, etc. *Specialty pharmacy medications are not considered to be maintenance medications.*

*Your prescription must be written for at least an 84-day supply in order to obtain at the retail pharmacy.

**Covered Specialty Pharmacy medications are limited to a 30-day supply. For Specialty Pharmacy medications, a Patient Max-Out-of-Pocket (MOOP) of \$2,500.00 applies per individual, per calendar year. Once the MOOP is met, the member's copayment is zero for the remainder of the calendar year.
